Incense and Bells

**Exodus 28, 30:1; Leviticus 2:1-2;
Psalm 141:2; Zechariah 14:20;

Vestments

Exodus 28, Matthew 11, Revelation 3, 19

- White** – Joy and Victory (Christmas, Easter)
- Red** – Holy Spirit (fire), blood of the martyrs (Pentecost, Palm Sunday, Good Friday)
- Purple** – Penance, amendment of life (Lent)
- Blue** – expectation, Mary (Advent)
- Rose** – joy of anticipation (Advent 3; Lent 4)
- Green** – Ordinary time is "extraordinary time" – life and hope

Crucifix, Statues and Icons

God said: Don't make idols and worship them (Exodus 20)

Then God said, make gold statues and decorate the ark of the covenant (Exodus 25)

Statues and Icons teach the faith, remind us of the glory of God; our family pictures

Postures and Gestures
